Sunday (day 1)	Arrival of mission participants in Nairobi Briefing at UNHCR Kenya Country Office
Monday (day 2)	UNHAS Flight from Nairobi to Kakuma Field visits in Kakuma Camp and Kalobeyei Settlement Overnight stay at UNHCR compound
Tuesday (day 3)	Field visits and meetings with UNHCR partners (first half of the day); Transfer to Turkana Basin Institute (TBI) ¹ Overnight stay at TBI
Wednesday (day 4)	Additional meetings with researchers and project managers at TBI Transfer to Lodwar, Meetings with the Turkana County Government and private sector representatives; Commercial flight Lodwar-Nairobi
Thursday (day 5)	Meetings with IFC / WB, GIZ, potential business partners in Kenya and the United Nations Office in Nairobi (UNON), including UNHCR, UNIDO, WFP, UN-Habitat
Friday (day 6)	Commercial flight Nairobi-Garissa; Meetings with Garissa County Government and private sector representatives, visit to PV farm and pilot projects around Garissa; Overnight stay in Garissa <i>Alternatively to the visit to Garissa / Dadaab: Additional meetings and field visits in Nairobi and Kenya</i>
Saturday (day 7)	Escorted transfer to Dadaab Camp (100km, approx. 3hrs drive) Field visits to Dadaab Camp; Overnight stay at UNHCR compound
Sunday (day 8)	Field visits to Dadaab Camp and host communities, visit to pilot projects; Overnight stay at UNHCR compound <i>Alternatively: earlier flight back via Garissa (commercial flight)</i>
Monday (day 9)	Field visits and meetings with UNHCR partners UNHAS Flight from Dadaab to Nairobi

Possible additional meetings, field visits in Nairobi and Kenya.
