- The Government of the Republic of Ghana (hereinafter called "Borrower") has received Grant financing from the African Development Bank, Climate Investment Fund and the Swiss Government acting through SECO, hereinafter called the Bank, towards the cost of the Ghana Mini Grid and Solar PV Net Metering Project (SREP) and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contracts for Design, Supply, and Installation of 35no. Mini-Grids for Island/Lakeside Communities in Ghana.
- The Ministry of Energy represented by the SREP PIU now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for the Design, Supply, and Installation of 35no. Mini-Grids for
- Bidding will be conducted through the Open Competitive Bidding (International), OCBI procedures as specified in the Bank's Procurement Framework (October 2015), the Standard Bidding Document for Procurement of Plant (Design, Supply, and Installation - December 2021), this IFB and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Framework.
